Market at a Glance:

- The state of Ohio is home to 13,907 manufacturing companies employing 851,775 workers. Some of these manufacturers include General Electric, Honda Motor, Stellantis US, Swagelok Co., Northern Stamping, Procter & Gamble, and Whirlpool. (Industry Select/MNI)
- As of 2023, Ohio's manufacturing GDP was \$133.16 billion, making it fourth in the nation, trailing only California, Texas, and Illinois.
 (U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis)
- Ohio Specializes in Advanced Manufacturing -Nearly half of Ohio's manufacturing jobs are in the thirty-five "advanced" manufacturing industries. Examples include motor vehicle and aerospace manufacturing, pharmaceuticals, chemicals, steel mills, and advanced metals. (The Century Foundation)
- Ohio's factories lead the nation in production of plastics and rubber, fabricated metals and electrical equipment and appliances. – 54% of the state's output consists of durable goods. (Ohio Development Services Agency)
