- Colorado is currently home to 4,486 manufacturers employing 194,848 workers. **(Industry Select/MNI)**

- Denver remains the state's top industrial city by number of manufacturing jobs, accounting for 29,962 workers. **(Industry Select/MNI)**
- Top manufacturing companies in Colorado include Lockheed Martin, Anheuser-Busch, Medtronic, Terumo BCT, Raytheon Technologies, and EchoStar. **(Industry Select)**
