The state is home to significant investments in electric vehicle production, such as Lion Electric's plant in Joliet, which is the largest dedicated production site for zero-emission medium and heavy-duty vehicles in the U.S. **(Chief Executive Group)**
- Top manufacturing companies in Illinois include Rivian, Ford Motor, Medline Industries, AbbVie, Continental Tire, Northrop Grumman, and Navistar. **(Industry Select)**
- Chicago remains the state's top industrial city by number of manufacturing jobs, accounting for 93,941 jobs. **(Industry Select/MNI)**
